

**Visual Case Planning Software Application Now Available
Allows Attorneys To Finally Plan Out Their Cases**

TrialSchedule is the first VISUAL planning application for your cases, presenting cases in a simple Gantt chart format which allows attorneys to finally view their cases in the current case 'phase' or stage of trial preparation. It complements an attorney's daily appointment calendar by providing the long range case planning tool which is simply missing from a daily calendar. The program is organized around your cases, not your daily appointments. It is an organizing and planning tool for your cases that will allow you to plan out your cases and stay ahead of upcoming deadlines.

TrialSchedule's main features include:

- Five separate colored phase bar types providing for case phases of 'Discovery', 'Expert', 'Pre-Trial' and others. These pre-defined phase names are customizable for your practice;
- To-do items for each case presented as pre-defined common tasks such as scheduling depositions, obtaining discovery responses and setting meetings;
- To-do item icons are presented immediately next to the case line, and on a separate Importance Matrix;
- E-mail alerts for single entries or across entry types;
- Create phase templates for specific courts with consistent deadlines
- Ability to assign cases and/or entries to specific attorneys or staff;
- Ability to sort and drill down data to view only certain types of data;

- Spreadsheet-like Grid charts of all data provide a detailed listing of all entries, with quick sortable columns;
- Export to Excel features;
- E-mail pdf copies of the ScheduleView and To-DoView main screens upon log-out as hard copy backups of the currently saved data; and
- Attach critical documents to entries such as court scheduling orders and store these attachments on-line.

Licenses are available in 5, 10 and 20 attorney/assistant license packages, starting at \$57 per month. Each monthly pricing plan includes telephone support, on-line document storage, unlimited e-mail alerts, and free application upgrades.

TrialSchedule is not meant to replace current calendaring software or current case management programs. This program is a new type of tool to be used for periodic review with associates and staff to mid and long range plan for your cases. Attorneys can finally visualize where they are, and where they should be, in each case.
